- Professional liability insurance.
- A current Vulnerable Sector Check, or the ability to obtain one before providing services.
- Clinical competency training or the ability to complete this training prior to providing services.
- A minimum of three years of clinical experience is preferred, although clinicians with relevant experience are encouraged to apply.
- Experience supporting individuals affected by trauma is considered a strong asset.
- Excellent assessment, clinical decision-making, organization, and communication skills.
- A commitment to ethical practice, lifelong learning, and high-quality client care.
